The papers will be equally published in the proceedings regardless of the type of presentation. Although detailed information (Guidelines for Authors Preparing Manuscripts) and an application form for offered paper submission will be provided in the second announcement, we encourage you to start preparing your paper following the style format used in the previous meeting.

PUBLICATION

The papers will be published as Proceedings that will be available at the Conference. It is important that papers are received by the submission date to allow time for editing and printing.
